2019 RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR THE HOLIDAY TREE PROGRAM SOUTH PLATTE RANGER DISTRICT PIKE NATIONAL FOREST

Cost: \$20.00/permit/tree; Maximum: 5 trees/per household FOR PERSONAL USE ONLY; NOT FOR RESALE Cutting Dates: Friday, November 29 – Sunday, December 15

Please DO NOT:

- Cut a tree without a permit
- "Topping" Trees Cutting only half of the tree
- Cutting trees more than 6" in diameter at ground level
- Cutting more than one tree with a single tree permit
- Not placing your permit on the tree after you have cut it
- Not removing the entire tree that was cut (all lower branches and stem wood)

Safety Suggestions:

- SHOOTING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUFFALO CREEK AREA AT ANY TIME DURING CHRISTMAS TREE CUTTING. §36 CFR261.58(m)
- SHOOTING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE SUGAR CREEK AREA AT ANY TIME
- §36 CFR261.50(a)
- Dress warm and be prepared for changes in weather.
- Forest roads may be snow covered and icy. We recommend you carry chains and/or use a four wheel drive vehicle; high clearance may also be necessary.
- Have a full tank of gas.
- Leave pets at home.
- Teach family members what to do in case they get lost.
- Bring a hand saw. Not allowed: chainsaws, axes, and power saws.
- Please be at the area entrance no later than 2:30 pm to allow for plenty of daylight to find and cut your tree. The sun sets early in December and darkness falls very fast.

Reminders:

- Trees must be 6 inches or less in diameter AT GROUND LEVEL.
- Trees must be cut 6 inches or less from the ground; do not leave any live limbs on the stump.
- Trees must be in the Buffalo Creek area of the South Platte Ranger District (refer to area map provided with permit). There is private land within the boundary. It is the permittees' responsibility to make sure they are on National Forest.
- Permits are NON-REFUNABLE and must be used on the date specified. Sunday, December 15 is open to cutting in the Buffalo Creek area for all permits as a 'make-up' day.
