Silver Ochre: Who Are US 2016, Observations from the 21st Century American Road

Through a series of 'moving stills', accompanied by a live original soundtrack and field recordings, 'Silver Ochre: Who Are US 2016' illustrates early 21st century America captured by two perpetually traveling artists.

From March 31st to November 8th, Thollem Electric and ACVilla will be touring the lower 48 states. They kicked off the tour in Albuquerque at Guild Cinema, screening the initial version of the movie which concentrated on the state of New Mexico. As the duo travels around the country, they will be recording moments and places in each state, weaving the new footage into the original version of the film. With every performance on this tour, Silver Ochre will represent a greater diversity of this country, eventually interweaving aspects of all 48 states. The moving stills focus the eye on the myriad of points where people meet each other and their environment. The music evolves spontaneously, each performance influenced by Thollem's sonic experiences in a lifetime of traveling this extremely multi-cultured country. When possible, Thollem and ACVilla will facilitate a Q&A Discussion with the audience.

The Jewish History of Leadville

The Jewish History of Leadville, Bill Korn

Unbeknownst to many, Leadville, Colorado, was once home to a thriving Jewish community, complete with temple, cemetery and well-known residents, including members of the May and Guggenheim families. There was even a kosher picnic in Leadville in July 1895!

Bill Korn, founder of Leadville's Temple Israel Foundation, will present a talk about the Jews of Leadville at 7 p.m. Wednesday, March 30 at Congregation Beth Evergreen, 2981 Bergen Peak Drive, Evergreen, and all are welcome to attend this free event.

Temple Israel, built in 1884, served a large and active Jewish community in Leadville until about 1912. No longer an active synagogue, the building now houses a permanent exhibition that documents pioneer Jewish life with a collection of artifacts. Leadville's Hebrew Cemetery was established in 1880, but burials dwindled at the turn of the 20th century. The cemetery was re-consecrated in the 1990s, and Jewish burials began again in 2001.
