




















Conifer's 5 Most Pressing Issues


93.14% Current empty storefronts should be filled instead of building new Commercial Developments.




Children's/Youth Activity Options





Architecture/Landscaping/Lighting



Prefer Architecture which is historically inspired but a contemporary look, large overhangs, many roof lines & steep pitched roofs

Use of logs or timbers and natural stone, materials and colors

Landscaping with native trees, natural landscapes with boulders

Retaining walls of natural stone

Down cast, soft white lighting to maintain dark skies.
