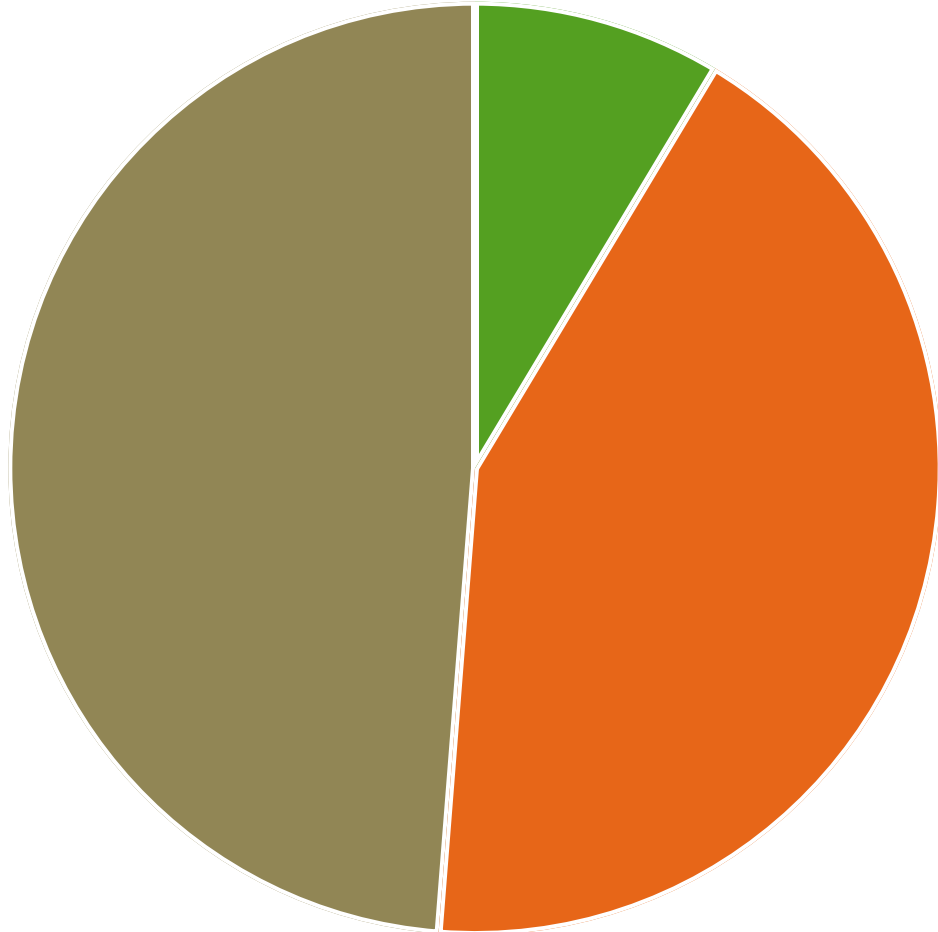

Age of Respondents



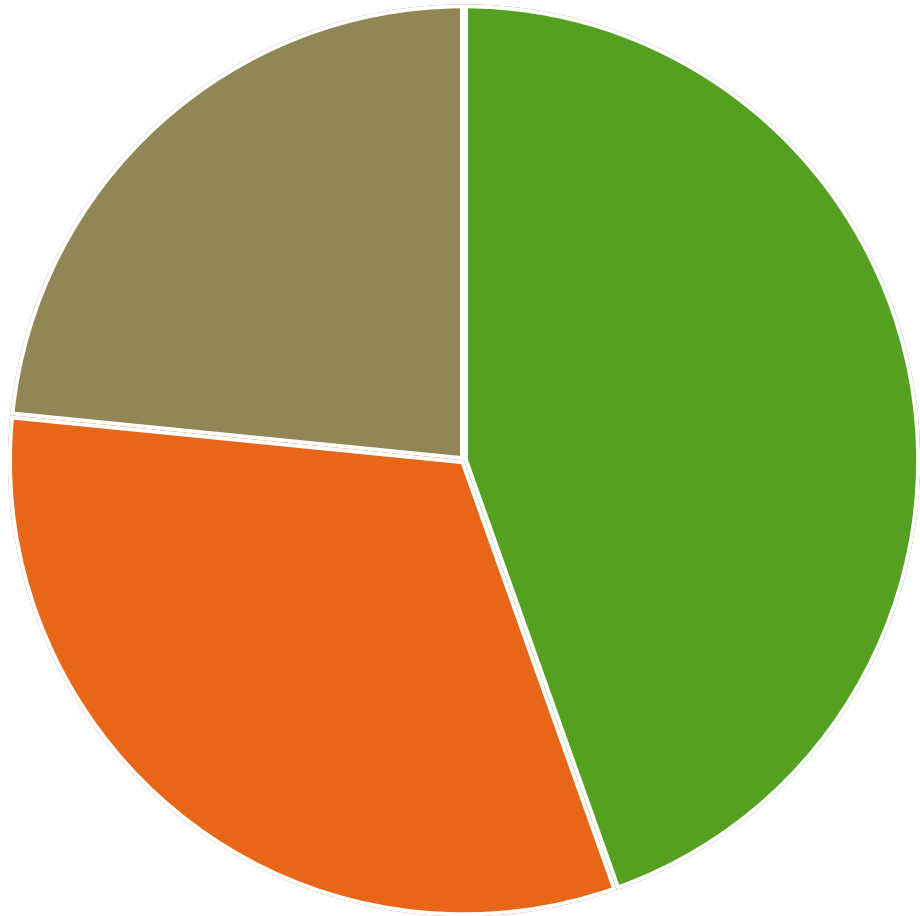

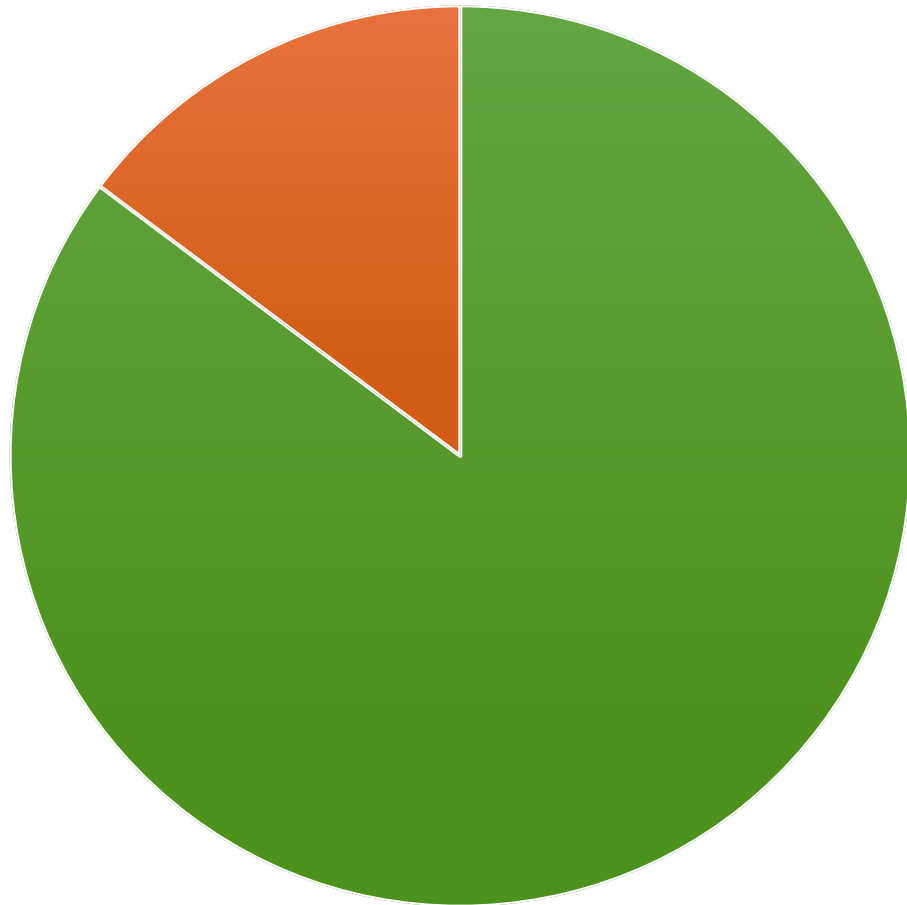

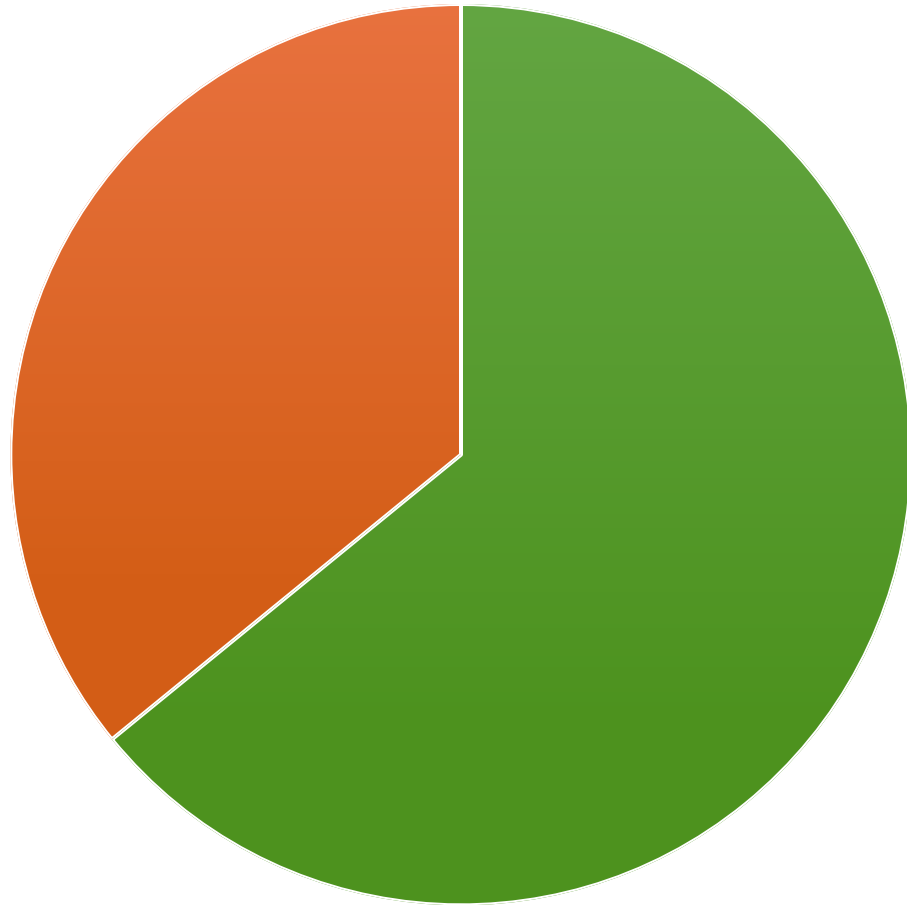

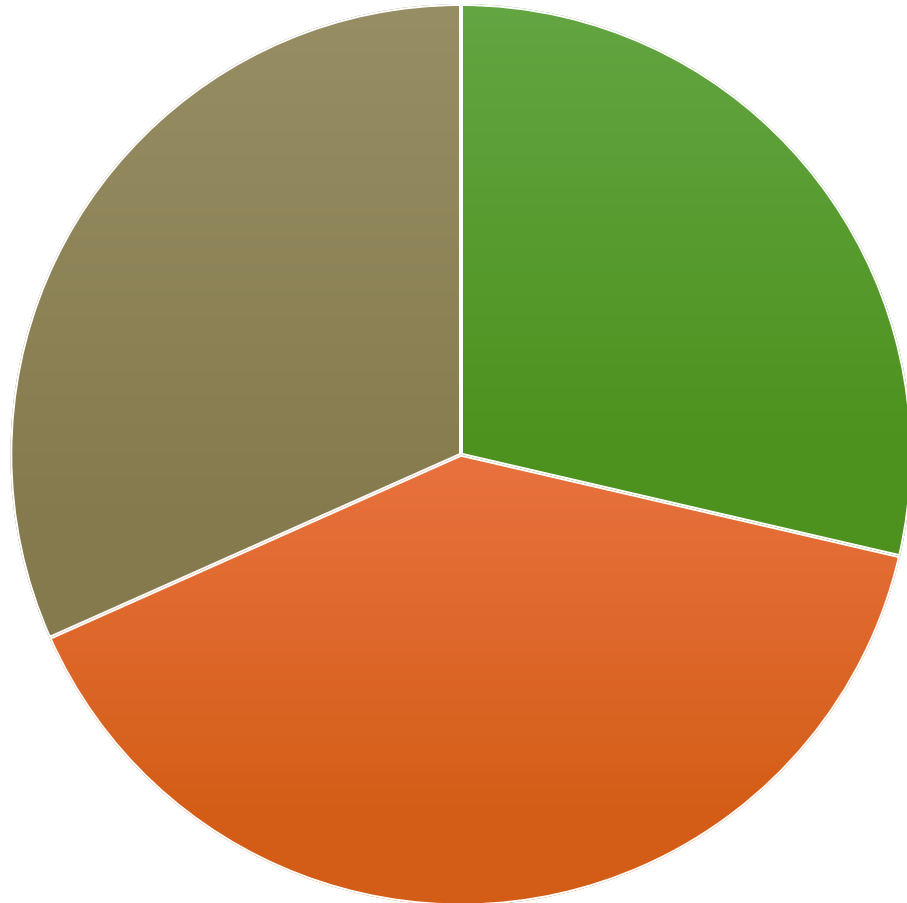

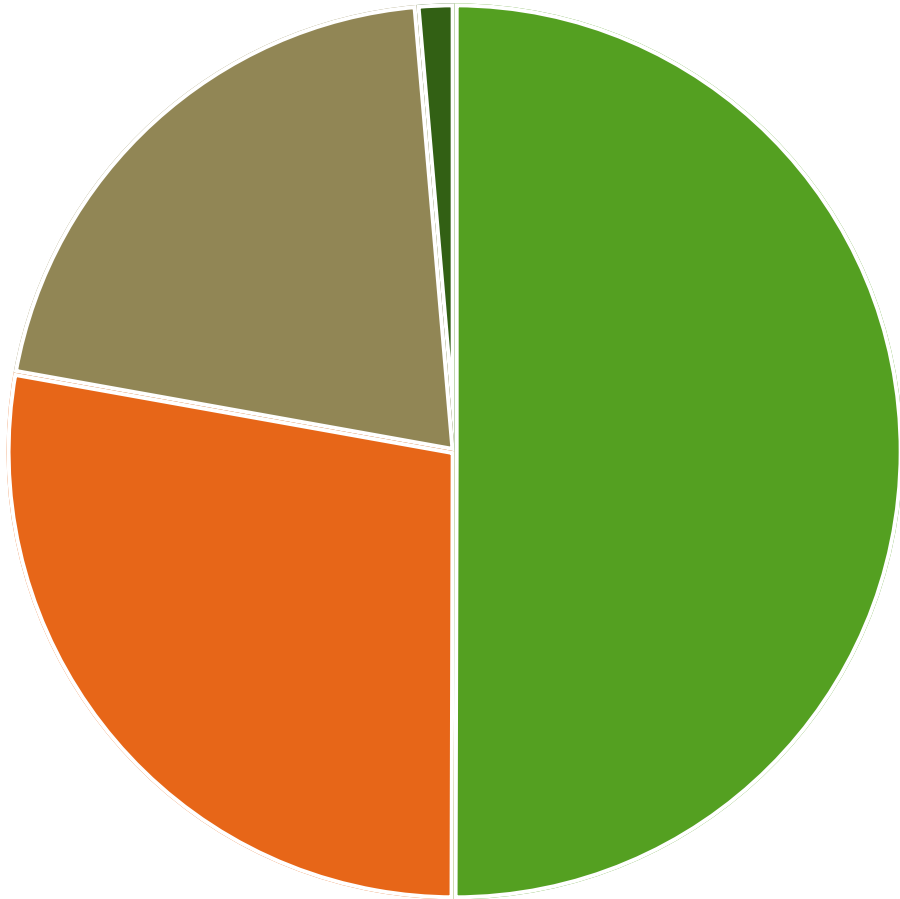

What is Your Work Status?



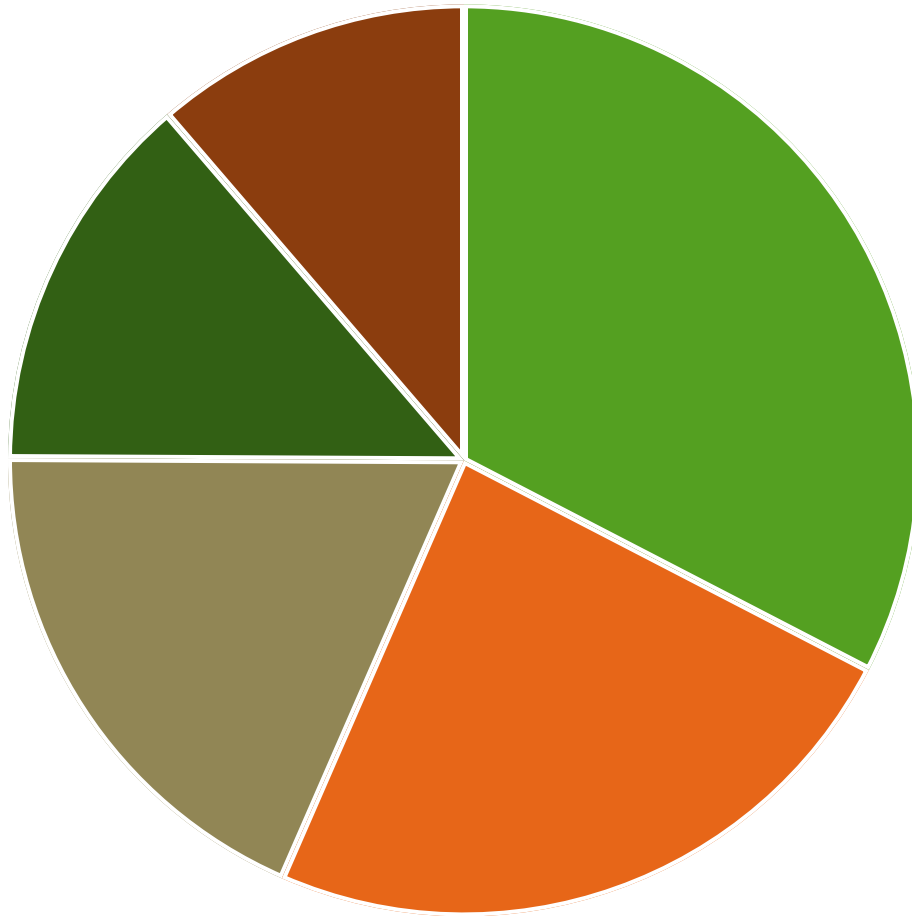

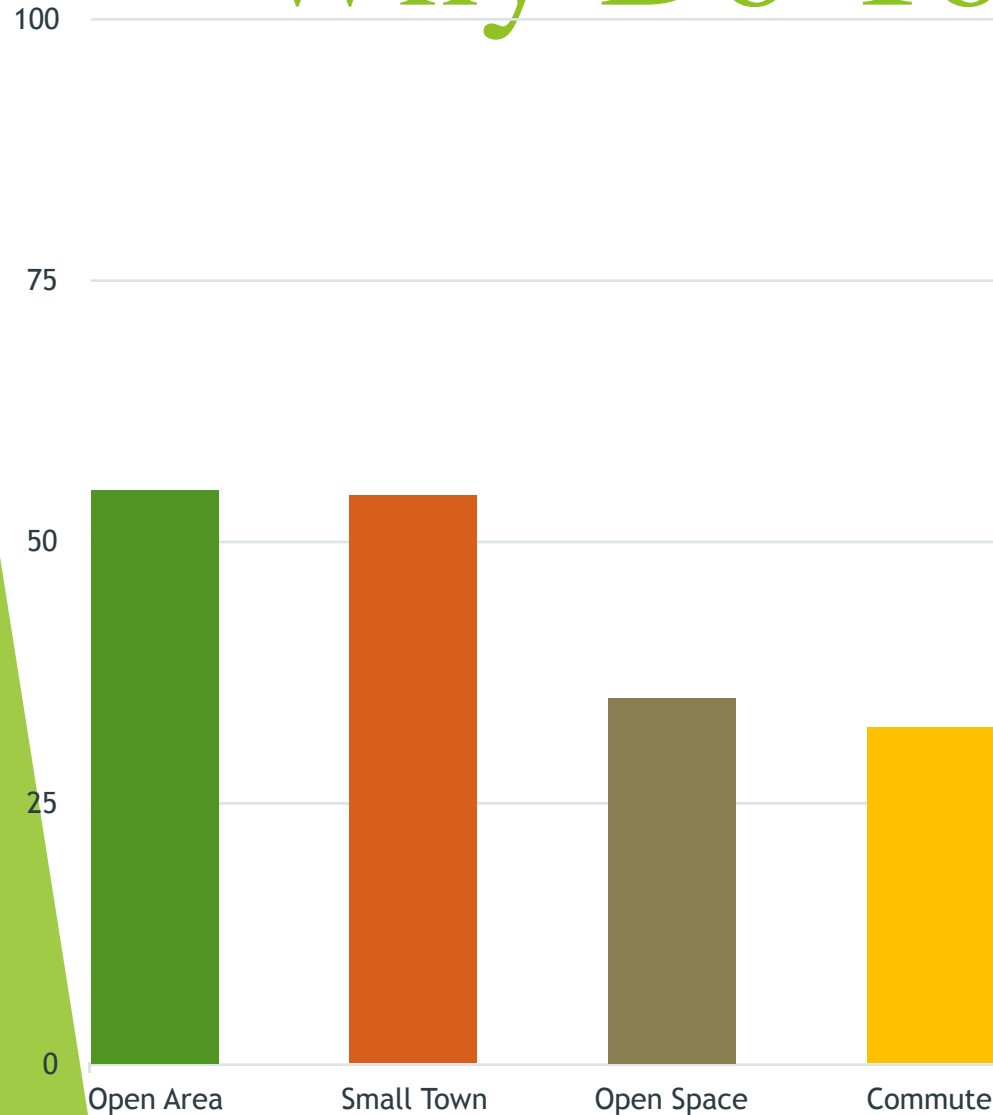

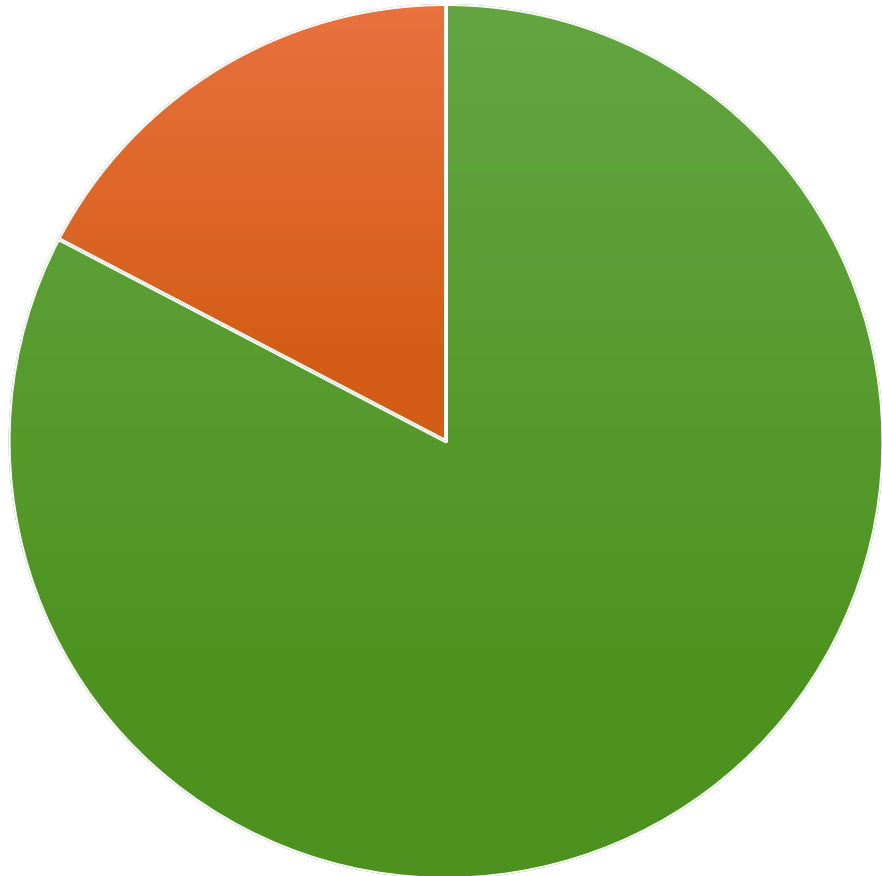

Conifer's 5 Most Pressing Issues



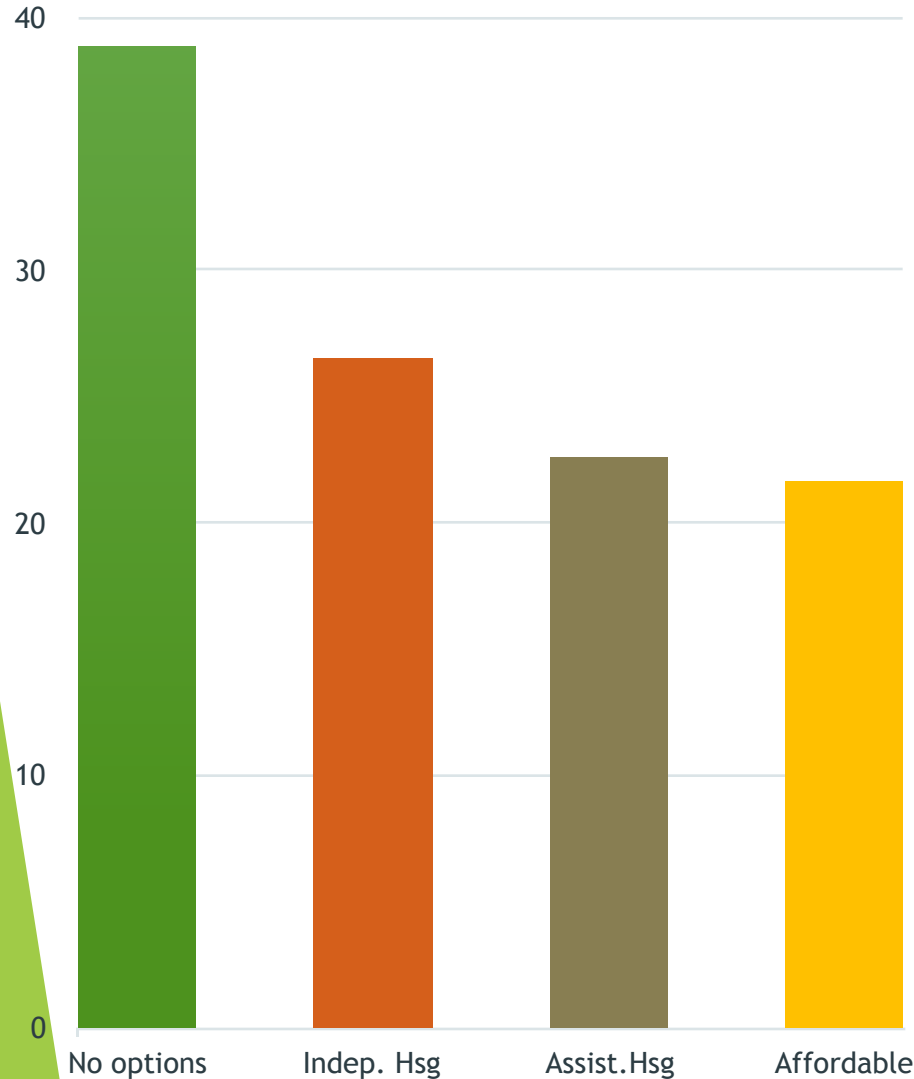
1. Fire Vulnerability

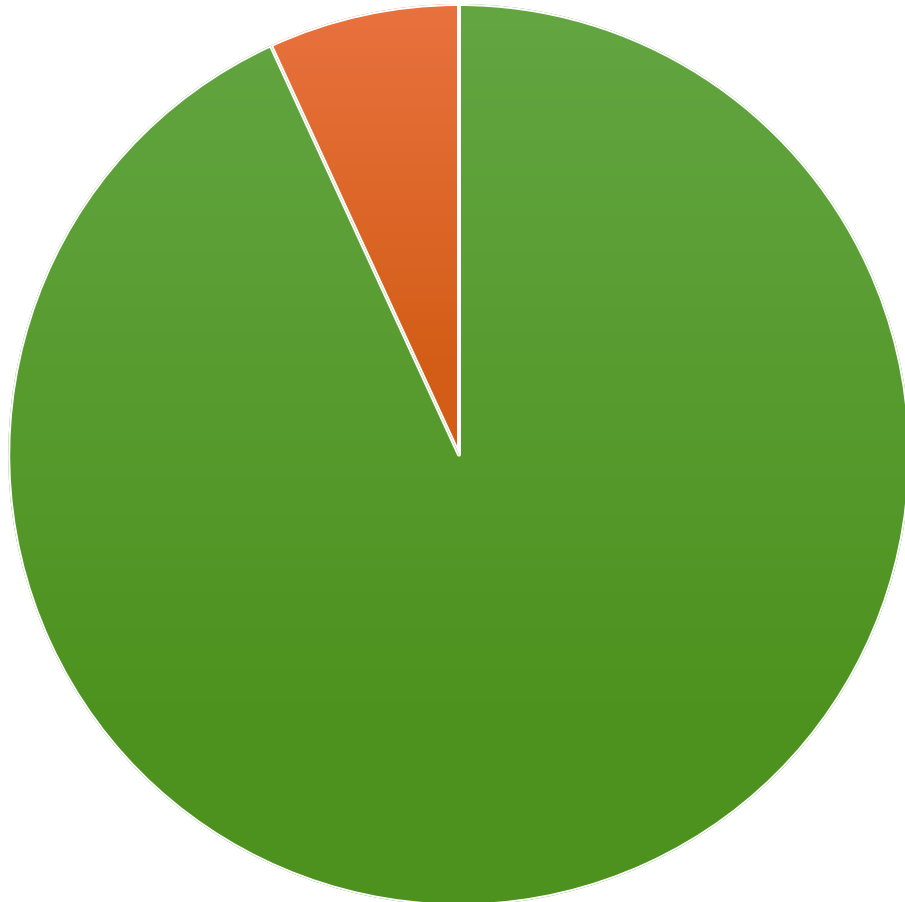

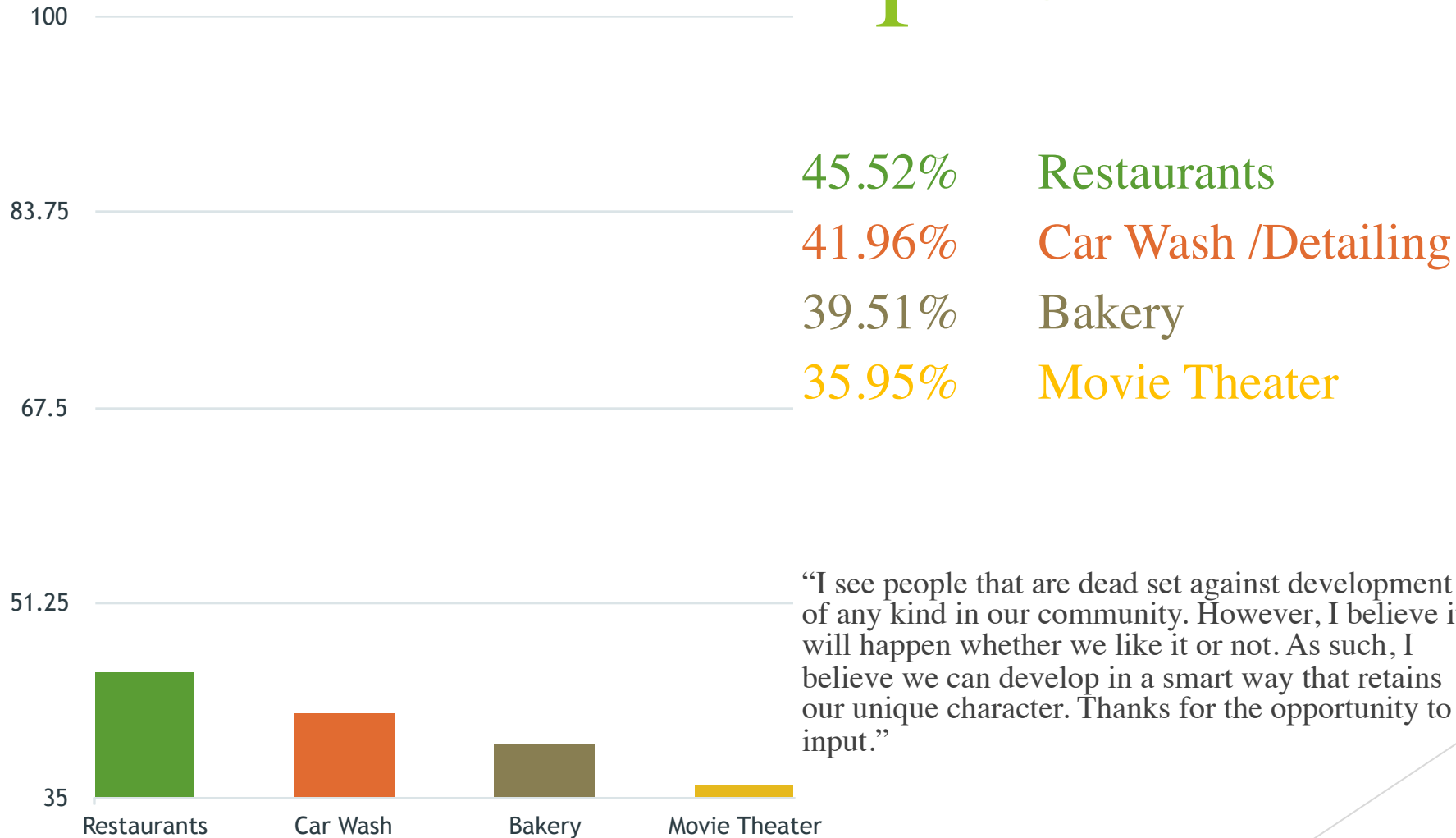


93.14% Current empty storefronts should be filled instead of building new Commercial Developments.

6.86% New Commercial Developments are O.K.

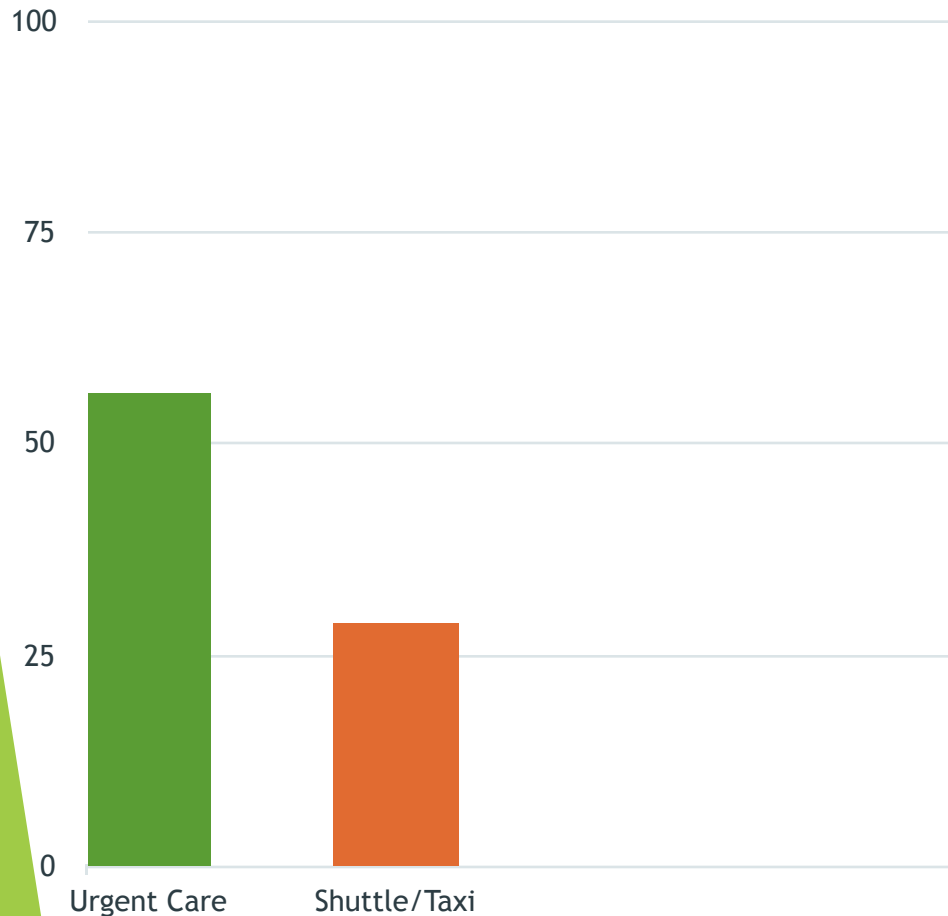

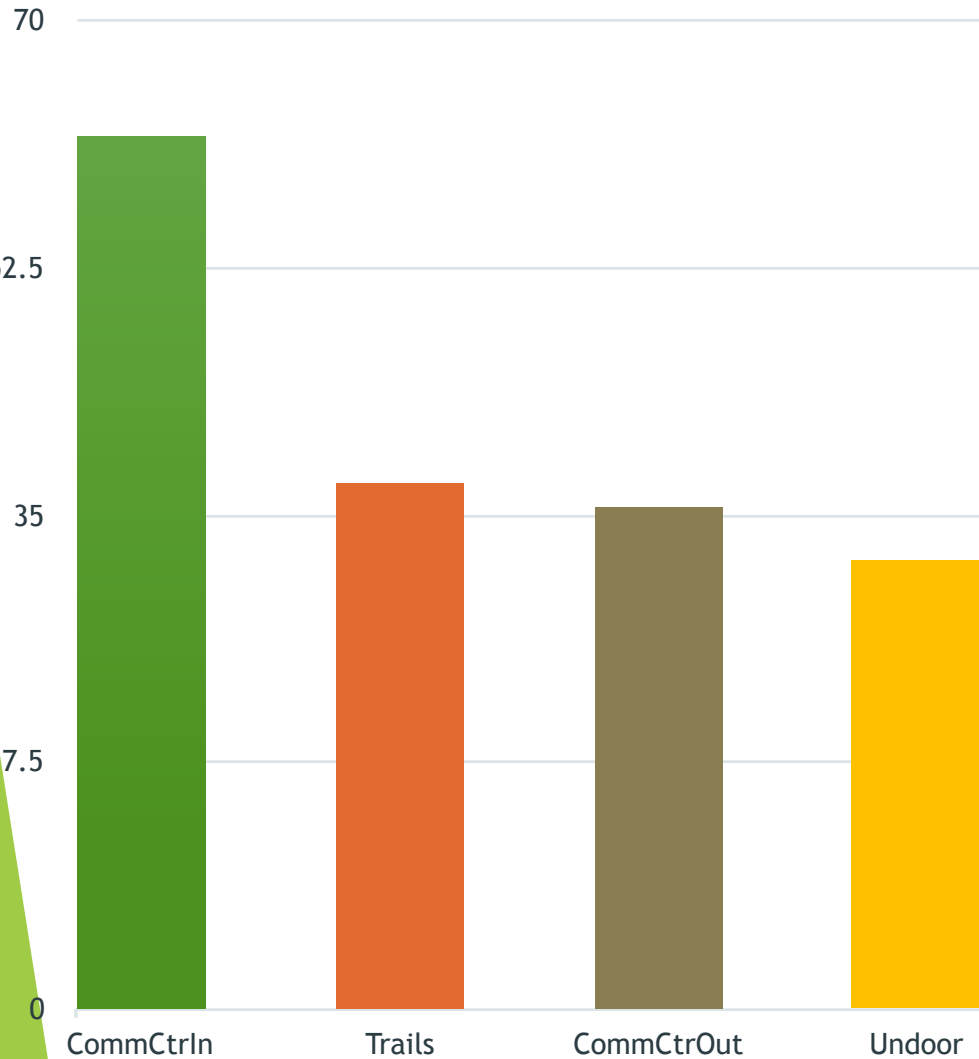

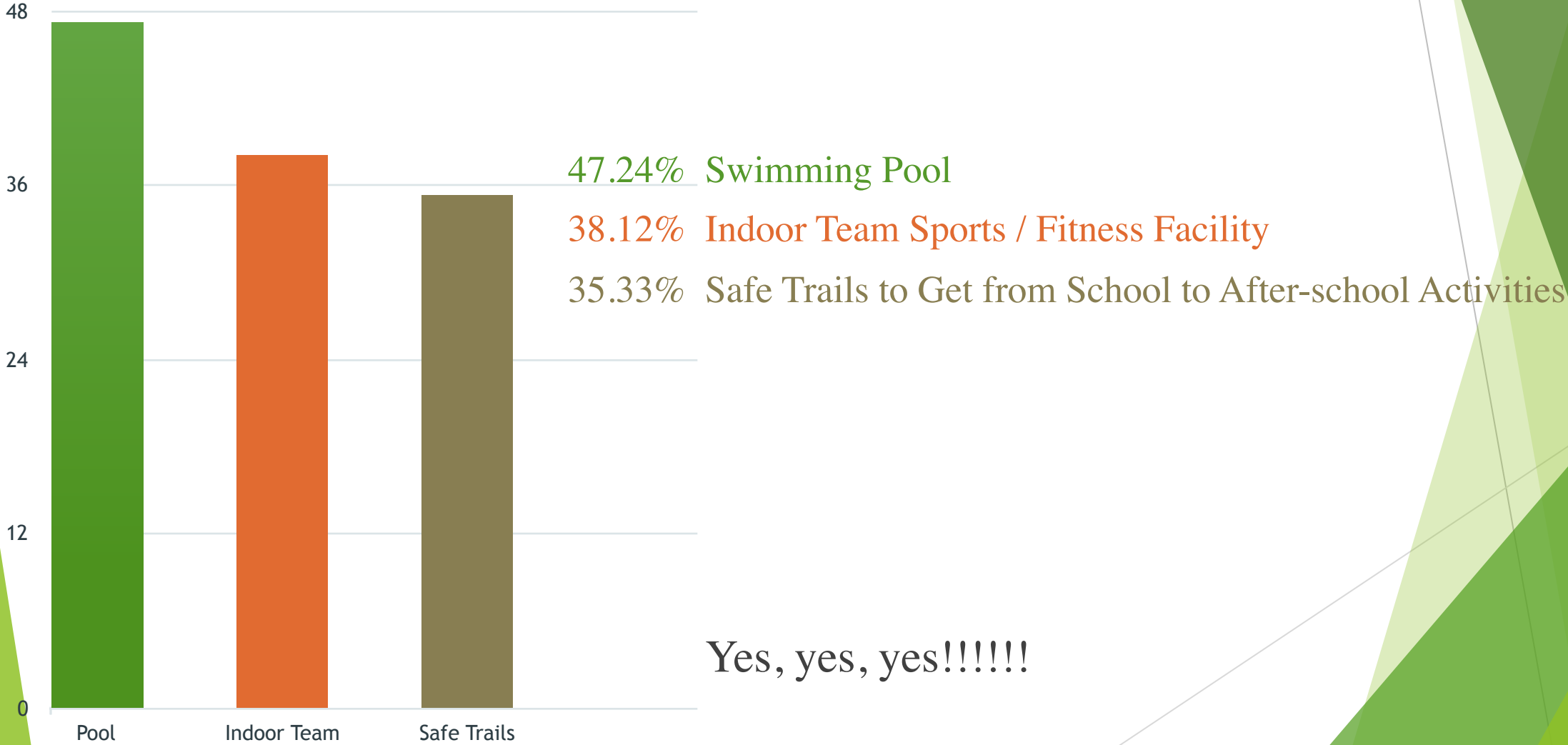

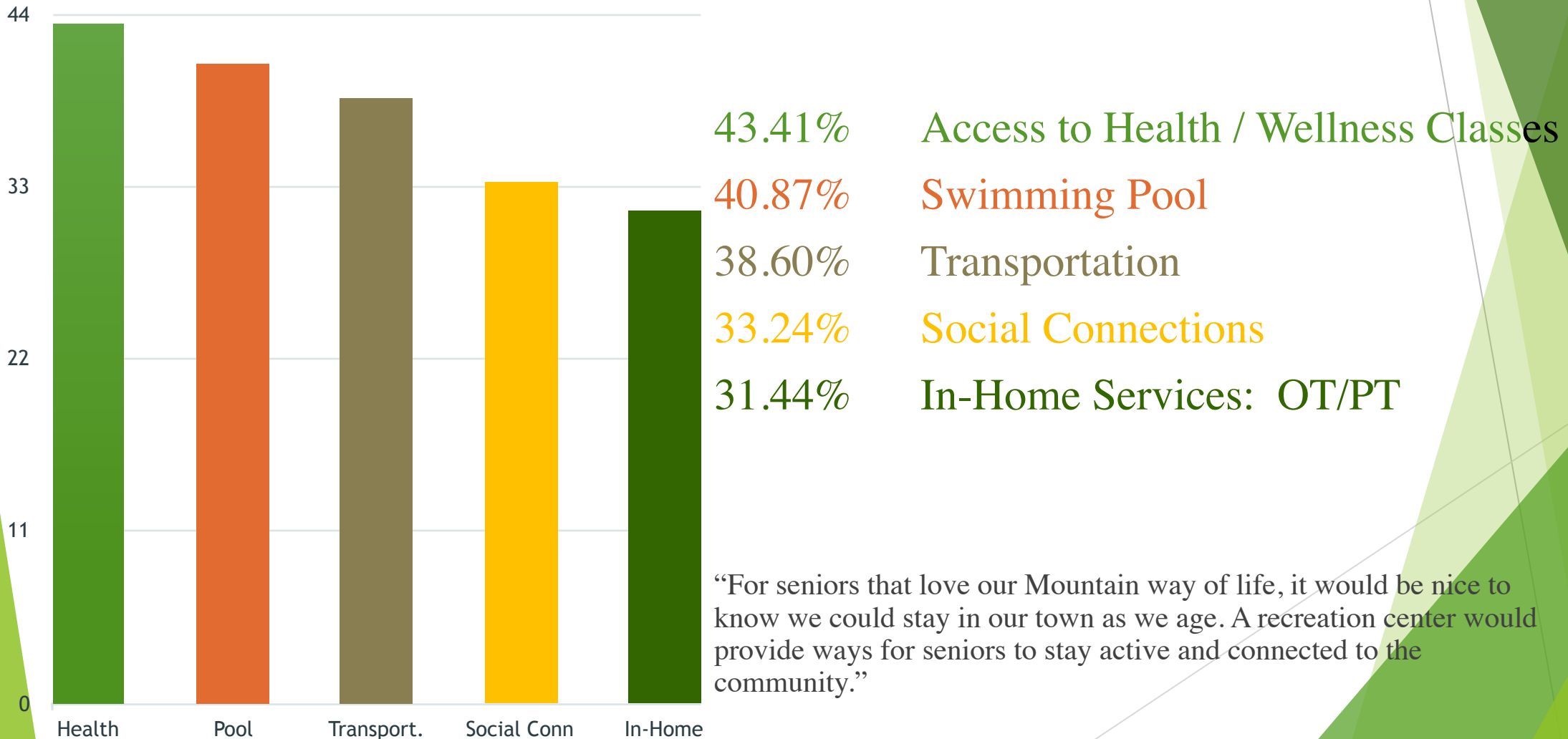

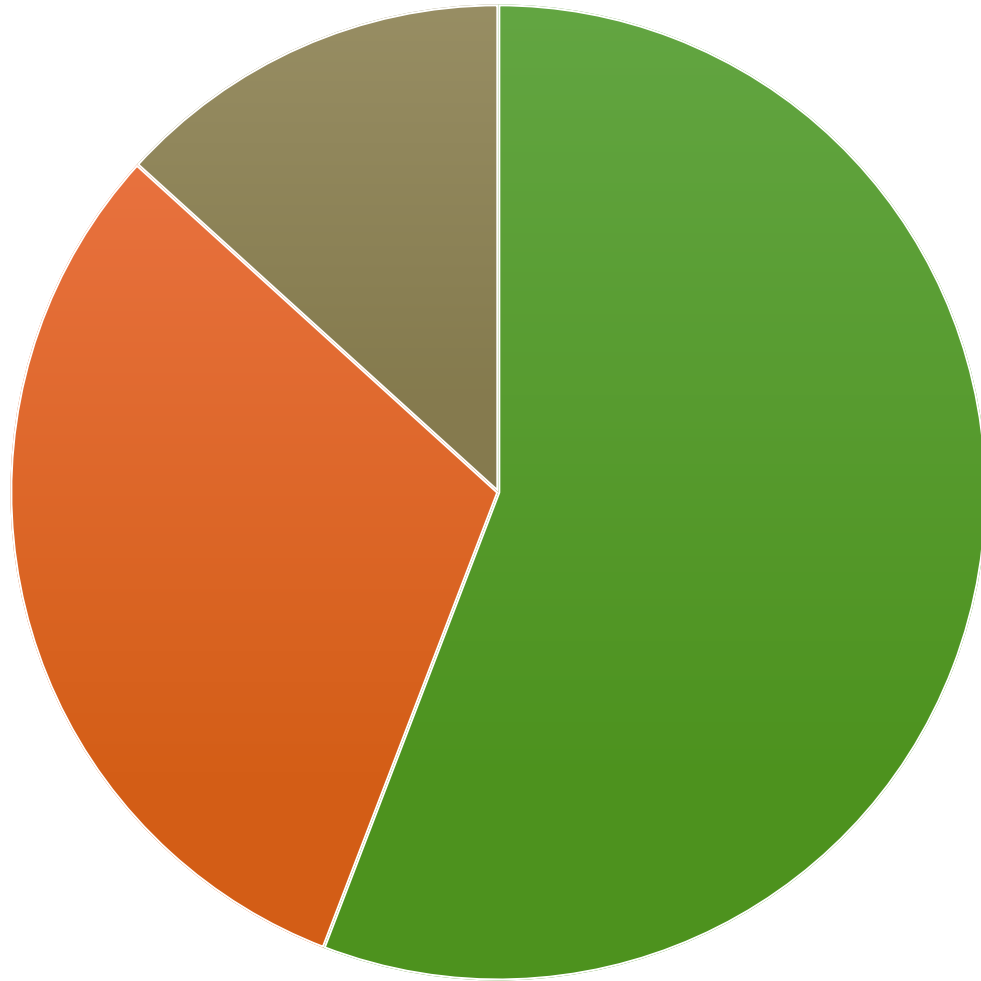

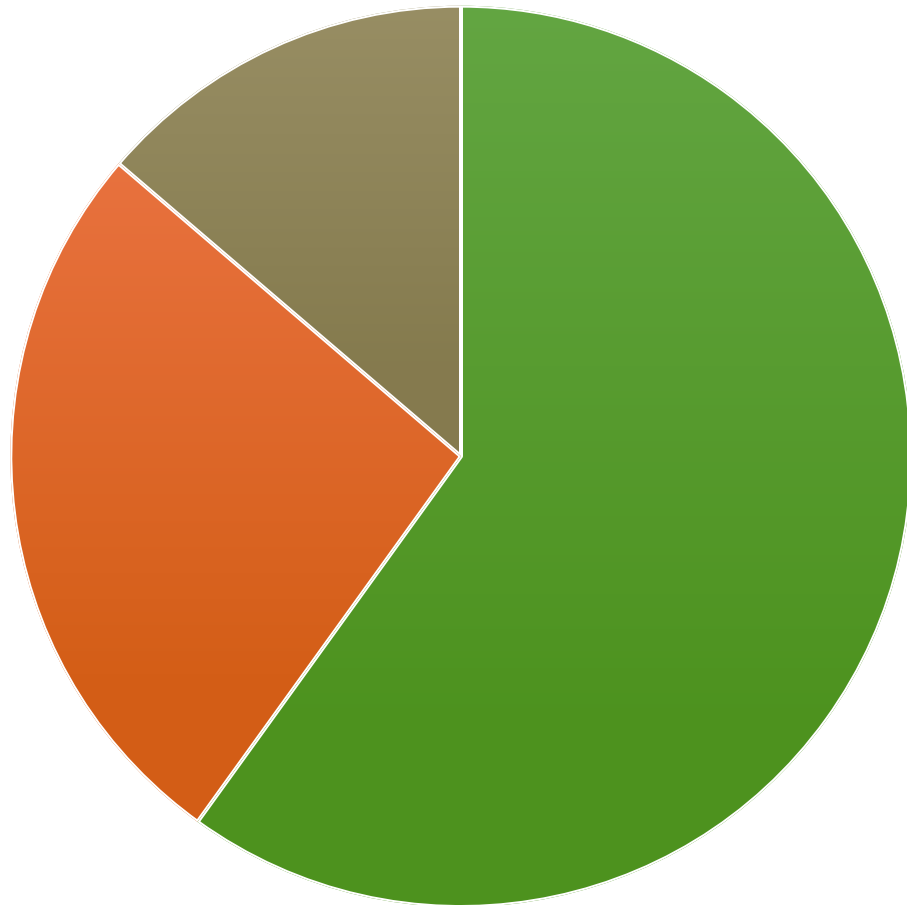

Land Conservation



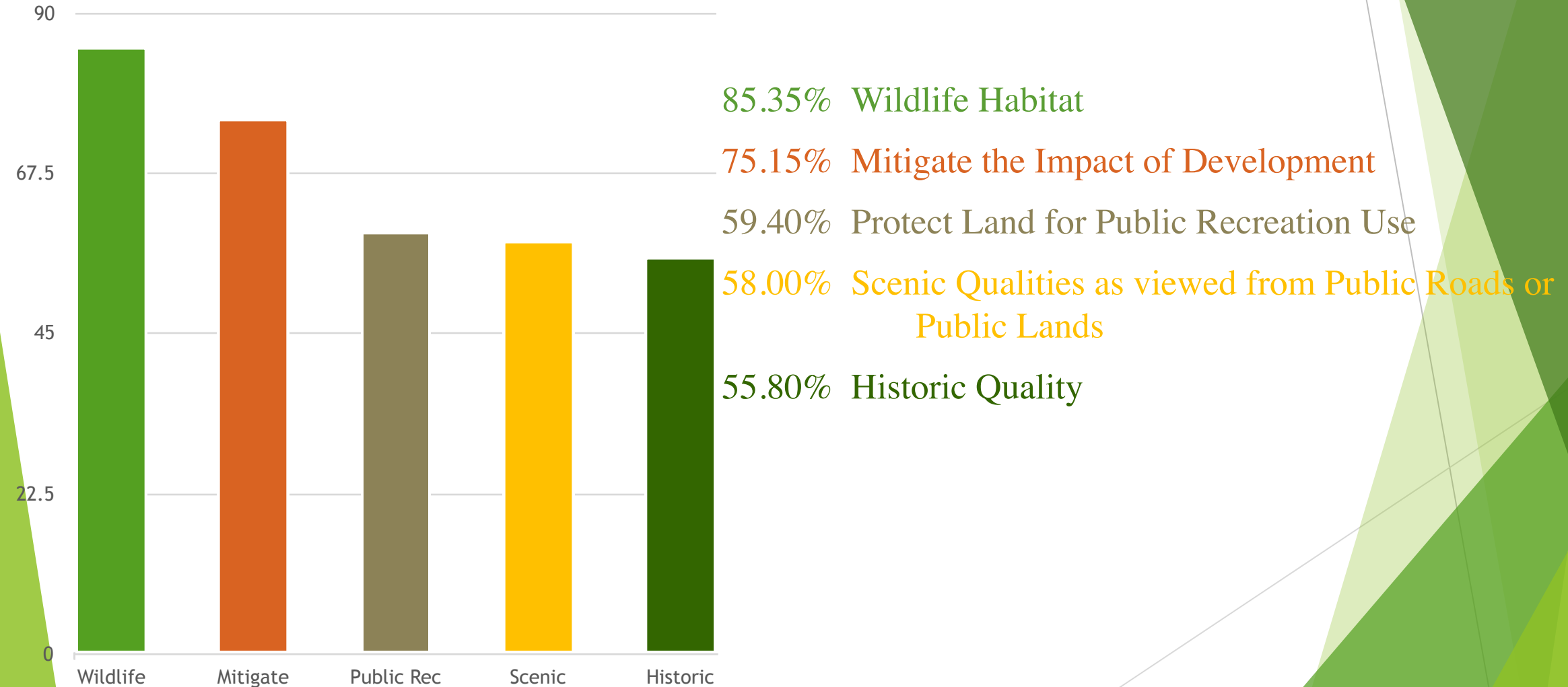

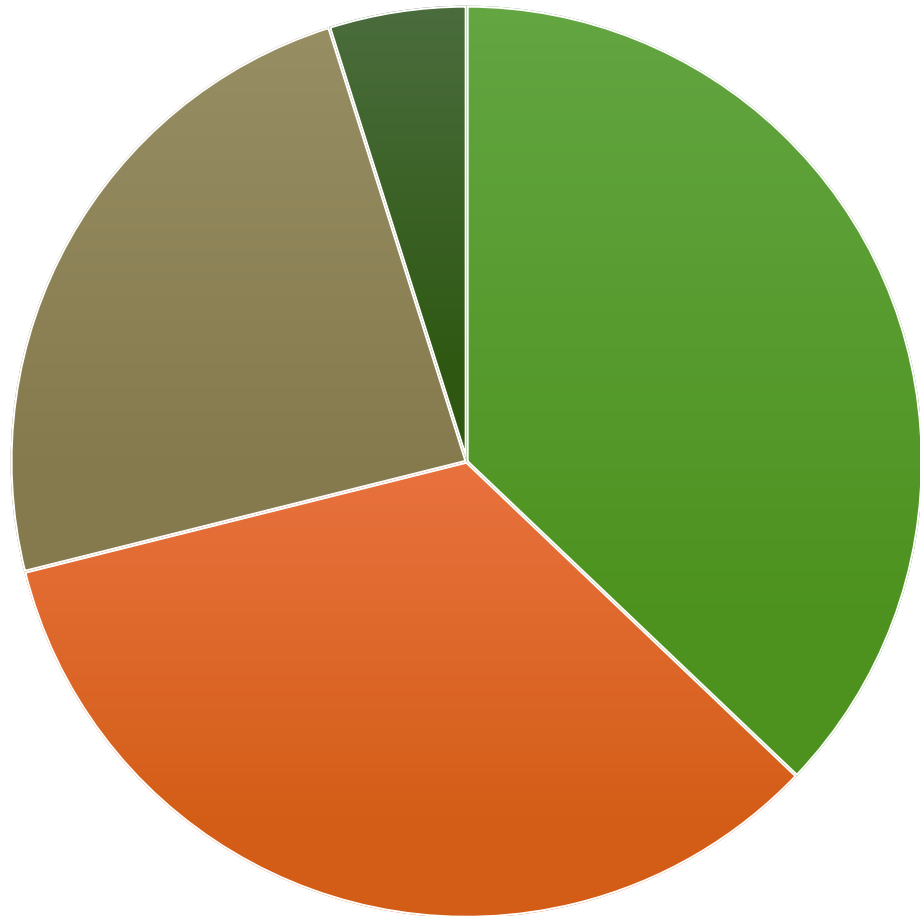

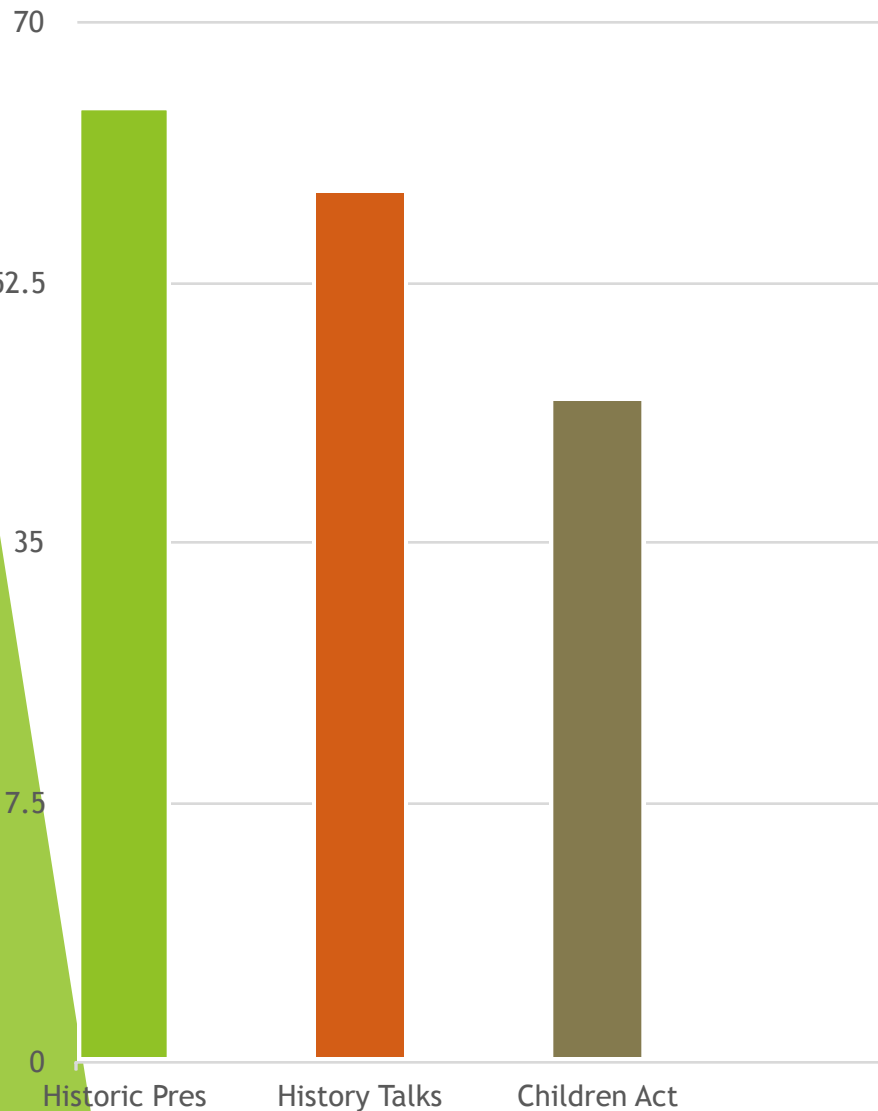

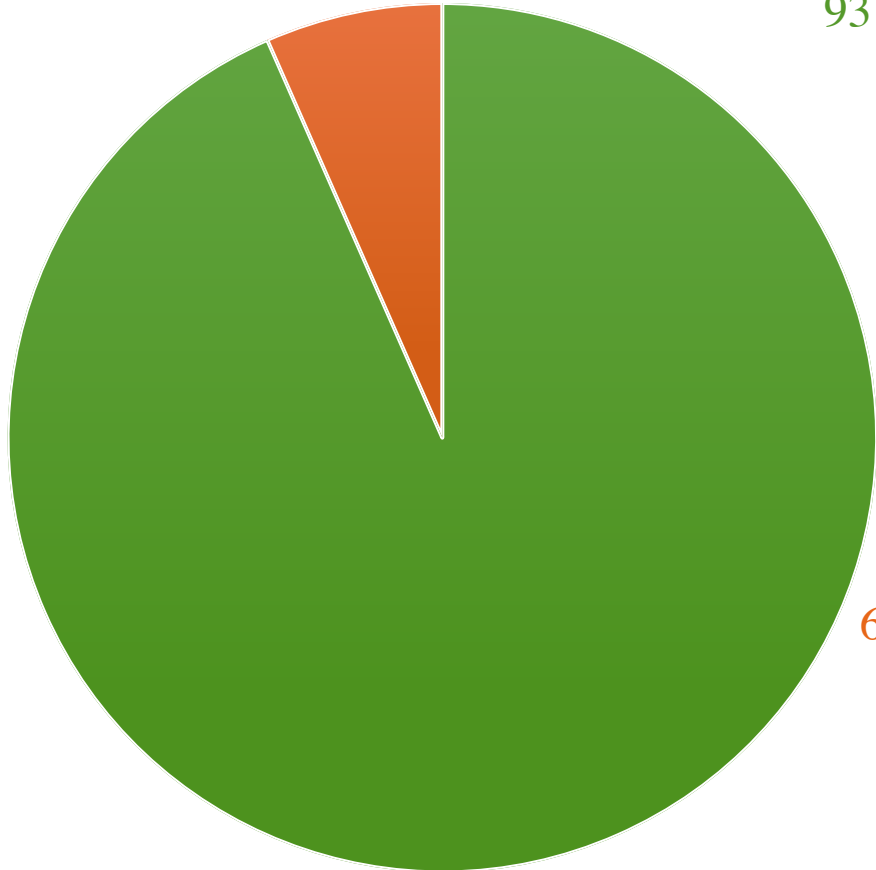

Programs & Activities for Children that Supplement Their School Curriculum

Architecture/Landscaping/Lighting



93.40% Prefer Architecture which is historically inspired but a contemporary look, large overhangs, many roof lines & steep pitched roofs
Use of logs or timbers and natural stone, materials and colors
Landscaping with native trees, natural landscapes with boulders
Retaining walls of natural stone
Down cast, soft white lighting to maintain dark skies.

6.6% Most of these comments related to not wanting these preferences for private properties, which is a non-issue as these preferences are related only to commercial properties.
