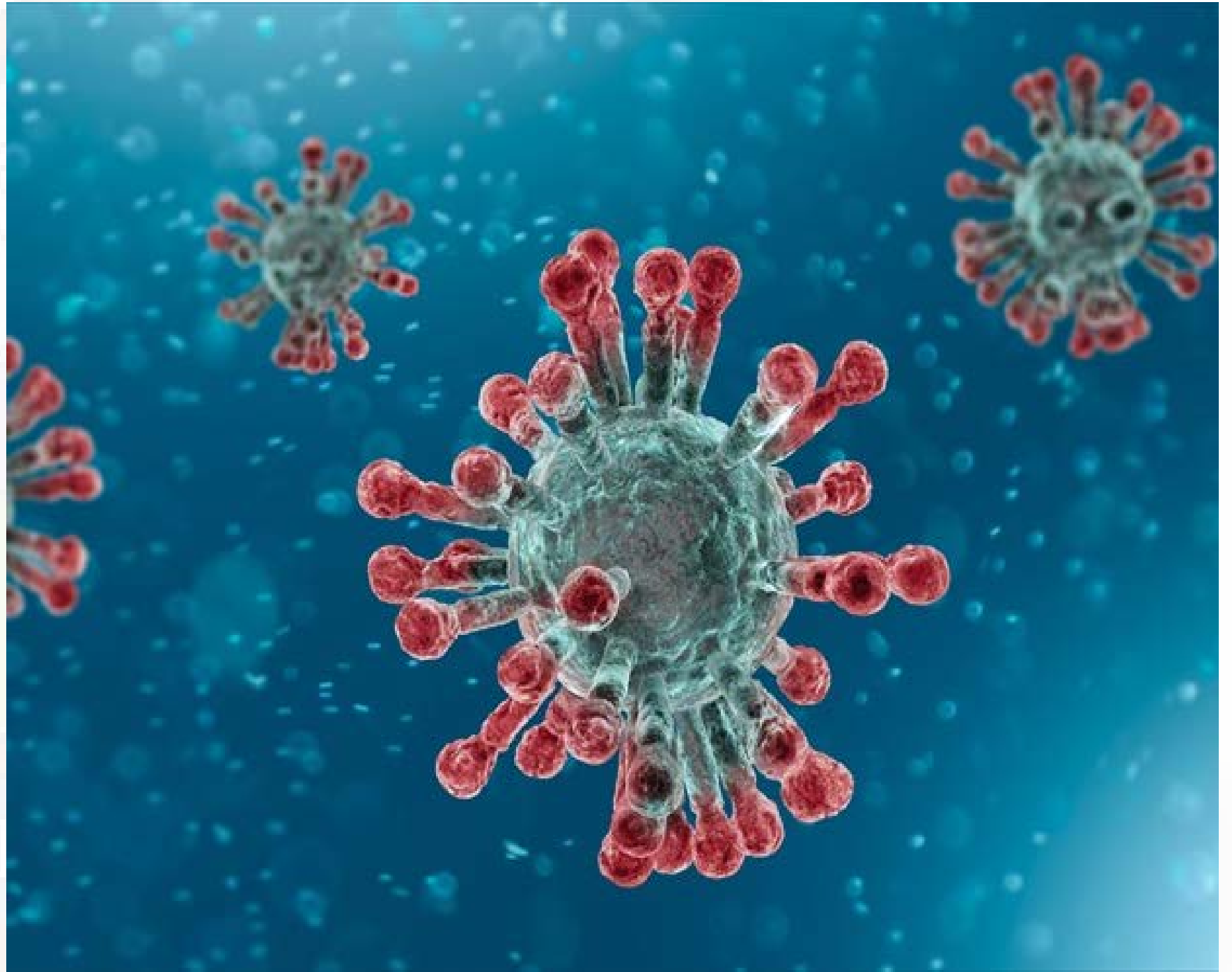

HOW DOES COVID-19 SPREAD & WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS?

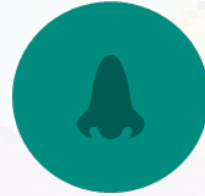
- COVID-19 spreads through:
 - Coughing and sneezing
 - Close contact with individuals who have COVID-19
 - Droplets that may have come from a sick individual after they cough or sneeze
- Symptoms of COVID-19:
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath

HOW WILL COVID-19 IMPACT OUR COMMUNITY?

- May impact our community in the future as disease spreads
- We need to take precautions to prevent the spread of disease
- People should take simple precautionary measures to help prevent the spread of the illness
- Simple ways to prevent spread- social distancing, covering coughs, staying home when you or a family member is sick
- Make sure people have food and medicine, consider staying home for longer periods of time if sick or feeling unwell.
